The Journey to Dream Initiative is a curriculum-based, unique, multicultural, evidence-based preventive intervention for selected and indicated populations.

Our program is designed for middle and high students whose high-risk situations, attitudes, and behaviors place them at elevated risk for future behavioral and health problems, including substance abuse, delinquency, and violence.

Along with a trained facilitator, the groups are peer-led and highly interactive, which sets these support groups apart from other preventive interventions. Youth meet in confidential, small group settings and learn essential life skills, enabling them to navigate challenges better and to:

- Cope with difficult family situations.
- Resist negative peer pressure.
- Respect others.
- Set and achieve goals.
- Make healthy choices.
- Refuse alcohol, tobacco, and other drugs.

Through our Dream Initiative school program since 2004, Journey to Dream has impacted and changed the lives of thousands of teens. We are excited to see this program continue to expand and offer additional support to at-risk youth.
